

Prompt Pay

In order to meet all federal and state prompt payment requirements, ADOT&PF CRO has developed a comprehensive plan for monitoring and enforcement on all ADOT&PF contracts.

[Alaska Prompt Pay Statute](#): requires payment from prime contractors to subcontractors within 8 working days of prime contractors receiving payment.

[USDOT DBE Regulations](#): requires ADOT&PF to implement appropriate mechanisms to ensure compliance on ADOT&PF's federally funded projects. To do so, ADOT&PF must use legal and contract remedies available under Federal, State and Local Law.

All ADOT&PF Contracts Require Monthly Reporting: To enable ADOT&PF CRO to monitor compliance with prompt payment requirements, on all contracts, contractors are contractually required to report on a monthly basis to the ADOT&PF Civil Rights Office. Prime contractors must report, by the 15th of each month, payments made to all subcontractors and suppliers during the preceding month.
