

RICHARDSON HIGHWAY

MP 353 to 357 ACCESS IMPROVEMENTS

The Alaska Department of Transportation & Public Facilities (DOT&PF), in cooperation with Great Northwest, Inc., will be constructing safety and access improvements on the Richardson Highway between the west Badger Road interchange and Levee Way, including work on adjacent frontage roads.

The project will construct new and pave existing frontage roads, construct acceleration and deceleration lanes on the Richardson Highway, install lighting at intersections, and modify multiple access points onto the Richardson Highway.

Why are these improvements being constructed?

Traffic volumes have increased 25% over the last 20 years and are expected to continue to grow. This means safety and access improvements are needed to keep traffic flowing smoothly and safely.

How does this project improve SAFETY?

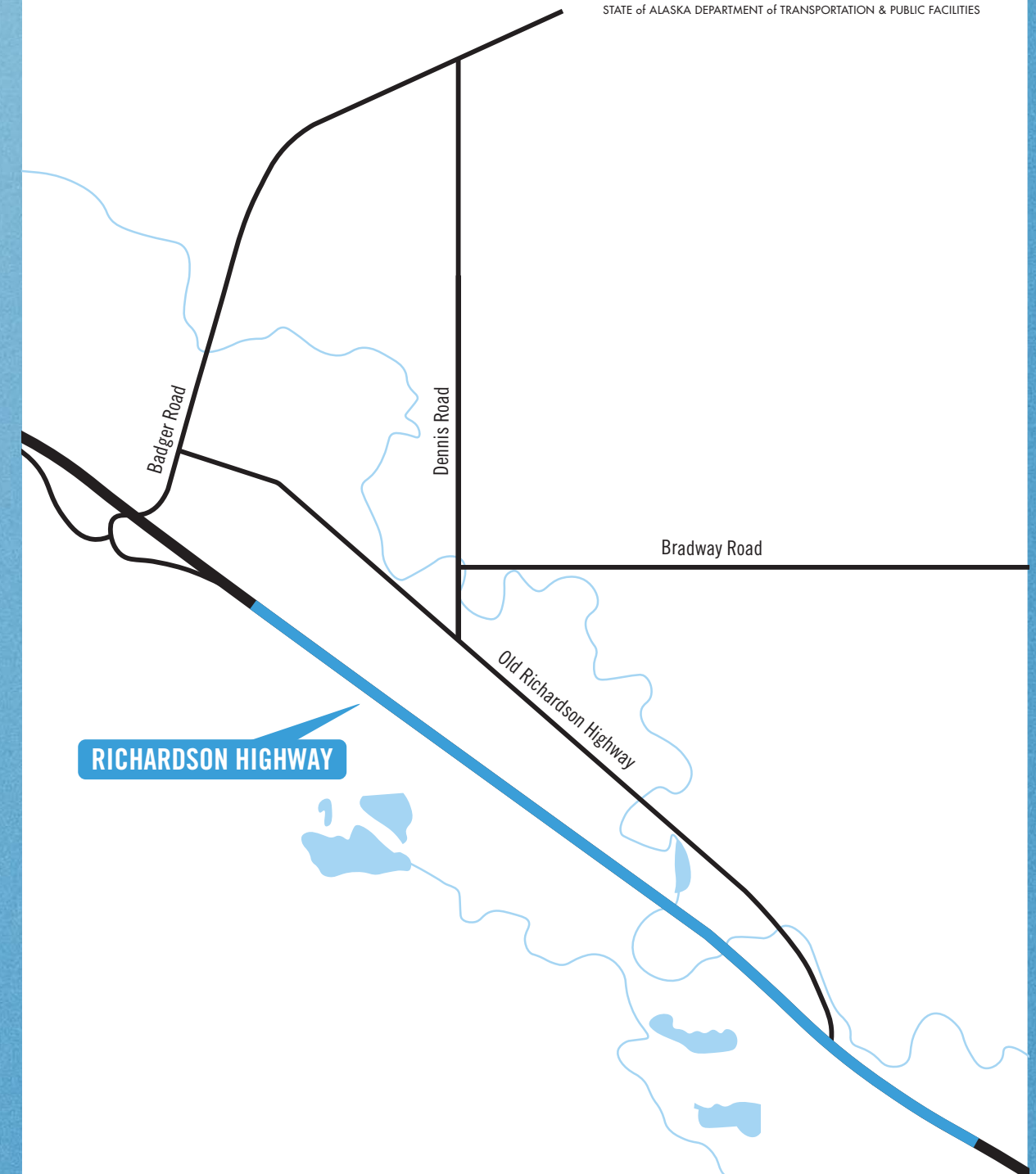
- Reduce conflict points
- Install intersection lighting
- Construct acceleration and deceleration lanes

How does this project improve ACCESS?

- Improve access for residences and businesses
- Construct new frontage roads
- Pave current frontage roads

This project will last for two construction seasons, with frontage road improvements occurring in 2019 and work on the Richardson Highway beginning in 2020.
